



Documents Requirement Explanation

1. Formal Photo

- b. Formal attire is required

2. Passport

The document must be properly scanned in color (not a camera photo). The passport must have an expiry date of more than 22 months from the date you apply for the program. Failure to meet these requirements may result in a visa being issued by immigration.

3. ITS Health Information Form

- 1. Complete all fields in the doctor's information.
- 2. Include the official stamp of the hospital or clinic.
- 3. The doctor must complete all required health status details for the applicant as specified on pages 1 and 2 of the form.
- 4. Provide the doctor's signature and hospital stamp
- 5. Write the specify date of issuance













4. Medical Statement

The medical statement should include the following information:

- Confirming that you are healthy enough to study overseas
- Includes a legal stamp from the hospital or clinic.
- Clearly states the name of the doctor.
- Contains your basic health information, such as the status of respiratory organs, digestion, blood pressure, and other indicators (e.g., cholesterol, blood sugar, vaccinations).
- The issuing date must be clear and no more than one month prior to the application.
- It is highly recommended to provide the medical statement in English.












5. Certificate and Transcript of Latest Education

Applicants for full degree program need to submit their latest certificate and transcript. It must be certified by the government or the Ministry of Education from the applicant's country of origin.



Applicants for non-degree programs need to submit their full academic transcript which contain all courses which have been taken during the semester. It must be issued officially form the home university.



- Describe what you will be studying and the main reason
- Explain your main educational goals, and how you plan to achieve the goals

10. Internship Plan

- Minimum 300 words
- Write clearly about the start and end date of the internship program
- Describe your topic, your area of interest, and the main reason for your interest in that topic
- Explain your main goals, and how you plan to achieve the goals

11. Motivation Letter

- Minimum 300 words
- Write briefly about your interest in joining the program at ITS









12. English Proficiency Certificate

- Must be valid for not more than 2 years
- Have a minimum score: TOEFL IBT: 64; IELTS: 5.5; TOEFL PBT: 510
- If the applicants from English-based school/university, a statement letter from the school/university principal could replace the proficiency certificate

- The letters must be explained about the application academic performance during the study period in the home university

- Applicants are allowed to take courses from maximum 3 different departments at ITS
- The credit equivalence between SKS (Indonesian credits system) and ECTS (European Credits Transfer System), is 1 credit or SKS is equal to 1.7 ECTS.
- Ensure about the maximum number of credits (SKS) for each degree Bachelor = 21 credits (SKS) Master and Doctoral = 15 credits (SKS)
