Laboratory-Based

With more than 170 laboratories at ITS, Laboratory-Based Internship (LBI) is a good place for potential students who would like to enhance and discover their scientific interest.

Students are required to contact their prospective supervisor at the host laboratory prior applying this program.

Sudents will be teamed up with ITS students. Please be advised that due to Indonesian immigration laws, internship students from overseas are not eligible to get paid during the internship period.

- Transcript and Certificate of the Lateset Education
- University Academic Transcript of Previous Semester
- Minimum score of TOEFL IBT 64, IELTS 5.5, TOEFL PBT 500
- Formal Photo
- Health Certificate Form*

Administration and Immigration Fee: \$150

Administration and Immigration fee USD 150 covers:

- Study Permit letter fee
- Airport pick-up service
- Residential letter
- Stamp duties
- Photo printing
- Fee for letter of police notification
- Other immigration charges for activities such as document registration, documents shipment, and service.
- Immigration online system fee
- Biometric photo fee.

Note:

The registration fee excludes the monthly fee of visa extension and local transport cost to the Immigration Office.
