Experience has proven that ITS can hold fun, enjoyable, and impactful topical short programs for international staffs and students as participants as follows:



Language and Culture-Based Projects

Language & Culture Camp

Language and Culture Camp is a short tailored program for learning Bahasa Indonesia and Indonesian culture while at the same time promoting soft-skills building among students and staffs. Usually the program lasts around 12–14 days and varies accordingly.

One of the camps was held for KMUTT in which the family of the university stayed in ITS for 14 days to learn Indonesian language, culture, gathering with local people, and of course, enjoying the beautiful nature of Indonesia.

CommTECH Nusantara

CommTECH Nusantara is designed for students who would like to learn and explore about the beauty of Indonesia through Indonesia culture and at the same time who can increase the competency of students through communication, language and team work activity who related with Indonesia culture.

We provide wide opportunity for student mobility, in which students, meeting new people from different part of world, understanding diversity and multicultural nature of future engineering roles, exchanging ideas & competency. At the same time, Indonesia is also rich with of ethnic & culture that a very good example in order to learn about multi-cultural understanding.





Anthropological Kampung Exploration

Kampung is known as Indonesia's traditional settlement where in big cities this settlement usually connoted as a slum area. As a metropolitan city, Surabaya has successfully transformed its kampung to be a livable settlement for low income people through go-green initiatives, and home-based enterprises that run by its community.

This program was held for the first time on March 2017. Representatives from University of Vienna came to Surabaya for a kampung exploration, studying and observing the characteristics of Indonesian kampungs, and the traditional touch of the people and the culture in a metropolitan city. The program was run successfully for 3-weeks and brought an impactful results for the participants and the society.

Engineers in Action

Engineers in Action is an international community service in which foreign students and lecturers team up with ITS team to make an innovation to solve real problems in Surabaya's kampung by applying knowledge and technology. The team works together and conducts several activities including data collection, preliminary study, and innovation project.

In 2017 Engineers in Action embraced NTUST students to deal with wastewater management problem; affording them to apply engineering methods on water conservation.

Global Leaderships Camp

Leadership is one vital aspect of an organization. Research shows that high quality leadership leads to better business and management. Development Dimension International (DDI, 2011) unveils that well-trained leaders will perform much better than untrained one. Developing leadership of university students becomes critical to produce high quality & ready to work alumni.

ITS purposefully designs a Global Leadership Camp (GLC) to enhance participants' leadership. GLC is a 2-3 week project-based courses in which participants meet and learn from great leaders, explore their leadership competences, and do mini projects to solve leadership real-life problem. Besides, participants also visit local small & medium enterprise, learn Indonesian language, and traditional music & dance.

Global Project Based Learning

Global Project Based Learning (GPBL) is a short course based on project. All through the project, students are expected not only to make a plan but also make a design, implementation and a fieldwork with the themes of ecology, energy, eco-tourism, community development, service, mobility, welfare and medical system, disaster prevention, multi-language communication, user experience, innovation, education system, global leadership & others. This program is licensed from Shibaura Institute of Technology (SIT) Japan.
