



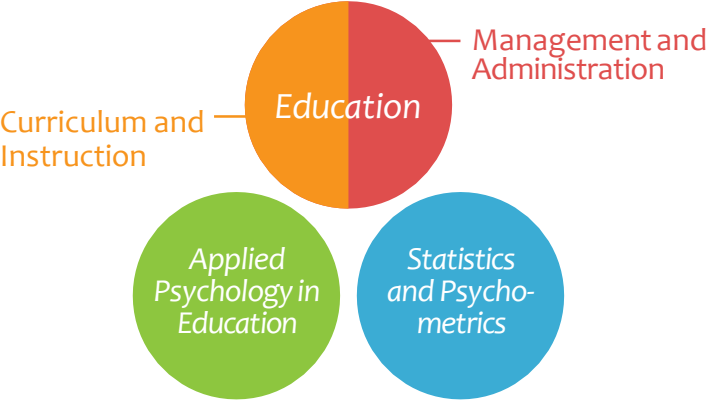
International Graduate Program of Education and Human Development
