Mahidol University Active Recruitment and On-site Interview for the Academic Year 2020

General Information

Faculty of Graduate Studies, Mahidol University, is pleased to announce “Active Recruitment and On-site Interview” for academic year 2020 to be conducted in Cambodia, Indonesia, Myanmar and Nepal. The recruitment of students will be for the enrollment for the academic year 2020 to study in the postgraduate programs at Mahidol University.

Together with the recruitment of the students, scholarships will be offered to selected candidates based on their academic merit and availability of funds. The scholarship will cover part or whole of the tuition fees and other related academic fees. In addition, some outstanding candidates will be offered monthly stipend of 2 years for master’s program and 3 years for doctoral program.

Eligible applicants for active recruitment

1. Faculty members of public or private universities along with staffs of their affiliated institutions
2. Government officials of national institutions including those working in regional and local government agencies
3. Staffs working in non-governmental organizations
4. Individuals who have completed Bachelor degree and have impressive educational background. (Please be noted that the admission requirement for individual Master’s and doctoral programs will be different and admission to some doctoral programs may require completion of Master’s program.)

Processes for selection of eligible candidates

1. Interested applicants are to sit for interview in respective countries and required to fill the form. Application form for active recruitment will be available in the link <https://graduate.mahidol.ac.th/ActiveRecruitment2020/>
2. The applicants need to bring the degree certificates, academic transcript and proof of their English proficiency test (IELTS or TOEFL), if they have the results. English score is highly encouraged but not a strict requirement for application for active recruitment.
3. Some programs require mini-test before sitting for interview on the interview date. We will specifically inform to the applicants about the test via email, if there is any, in advance.
4. Successful candidates from the interview will be notified within 2 weeks after the interview. Faculty of Graduate Studies will guide them to apply for formal admission process. The program of study and Faculty of Graduate Studies will process and consider the applications and documents, and the candidates will be notified for final decision before May, 2019.



5. Those who had applied active recruitment of Mahidol University for previous years can also apply for this year. The university appreciates the effort and interest of the applicants to study at Mahidol University.
6. Some of the programs will not join the active recruitment, and if a particular program is not listed in active recruitment website, application for admission and scholarship can still be made at <https://graduate.mahidol.ac.th/en/>.
7. On-site interview will be conducted in the following date. The details of venue in each country will be announced in the website on 1 January, 2020.
