## OBJECTIVES

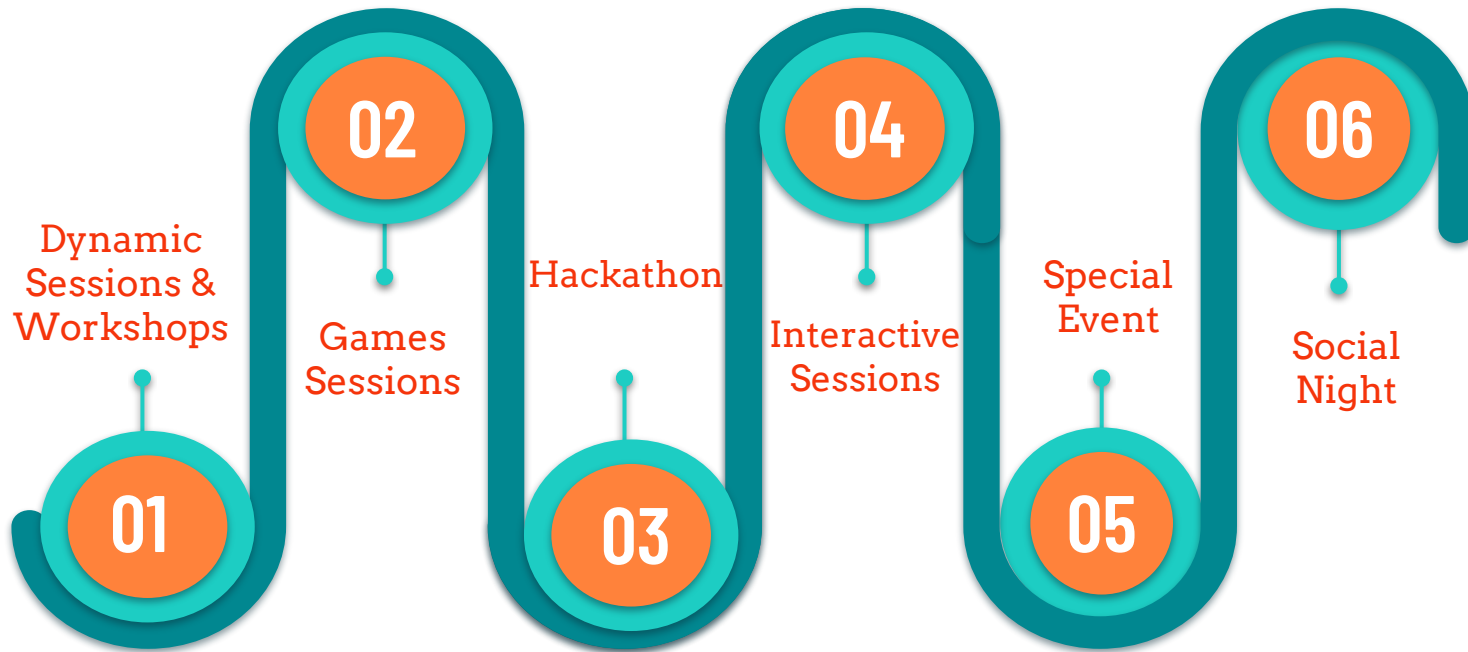
- To develop leadership skills, focus on management, social and self-discipline aspects and think more critically and rationally.
