## Thailand Pass System

## (Registration System for Entering Thailand (for air travel only))

Applicants can use their approved Thailand Pass QR Code to enter Thailand on different date of arrival if the new date of arrival is within 7 days before or after the original date of arrival as indicated on the QR Code (no need to re-apply or modify your application). Please note that applicants are required to show proof of revised hotel accommodation that corresponds to the new travel dates, and non-Thais are also required to show proof of insurance with at least 20,000 USD coverage for medical treatments in Thailand for the entire duration of their revised travel itinerary. Failure to produce these documents may result in denied boarding. Further note that each Thailand Pass QR Code can be used only once.

In the case that your arrival port is Suvarnabhumi International Airport, please check your hotel counter number via <a href="https://checkinextraplus.workationthailand.com/">https://checkinextraplus.workationthailand.com/</a>

From 1 April 2022, travellers entering Thailand under every entry scheme are no longer required to present a COVID-19 RT-PCR test result upon arrival in Thailand. However, they still have to undergo a COVID-19 RT-PCR test as specified in their entry scheme (Test on Day 1 for Test and Go / Sandbox or Test on Day 4 - 5 for AQ)

## Announcement

Monday, April 18, 2022

To ensure sufficient time for the registration and approval process in the Thailand Pass system and eliminate the need for travelers to adjust their travel itinerary, from 10 February 2022 onwards, Thailand Pass system will not permit registration less than 2 day before departure date. (to ensure smooth journey it is highly recommended that you plan your travel at least 7 days in advance). In case of emergency travel, please send your request / supporting documents to testgo@consular.go.th

\* The processing time for Thailand Pass is 3 - 7 days. Applicants are strongly advised to plan ahead and submit the registration for Thailand Pass at least 7 days prior to departure \*

Approval process

1. Upon submission of your registration, staff of your booked hotel will authenticate the reservation.

Once verified/approved, your registration application will be sent to the Department of Disease

Control (DDC) officials for further consideration (vaccine certificate etc.)

- The hotel will reject any incomplete or non-compliance documentation, and a notification email

will be sent to resubmit the additional documents. For any inquiries at this stage, please contact

your hotel directly.

2. After hotel authentication and approval, the Department of Disease Control (DDC) will verify your

Certificate of Vaccination and the Thailand Pass QR Code will be sent to you via email within 3 - 7

days.

- The DDC will reject any incomplete or non-compliance documentation, and a notification email

will be sent to you alongside the reasons why your registration is rejected.

- Medical expenses coverage of 20,000 USD minimum.

- Hospital isolation.

- Your insurance policy must be valid for the entire duration of your stay in Thailand.
