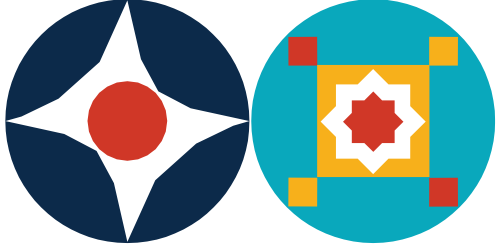
### Flow of Application
