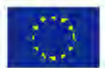

EPS STRUCTURE

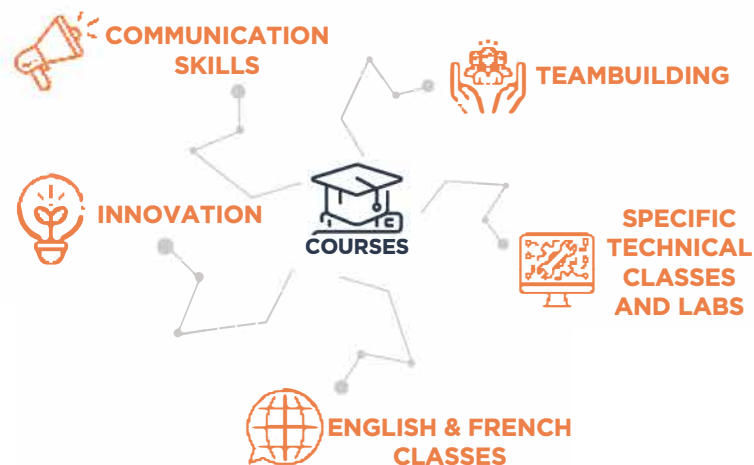
The EPS has two complementary parts:



PROJECT WORK
