# **Important Notice for Exchange Students**

### Visa

All international exchange students shall apply for visitor visa/resident visa depending on the following circumstances.

- Visitor's visa (exchange for 1 semester): For those who will stay in Taiwan for less than 6 months, extension available in Taiwan. Info Here
- Resident Visas (exchange for 1 year): For those who will study in Taiwan for more than 6 months, extension available in Taiwan. Info Here

**PS.** Those who arrive in Taiwan with Resident Visa need to apply for **Alien Resident Certificate (ARC)** within 15 days from arrival date. **ARC application information** 

## **Medical Insurance**

### \*\*Updated on Dec. 28th, 2022\*\*

In case of any medical expenses caused by Covid-19 or other emergencies, please buy medical insurance in your home country and upload the document to the <a href="Exchange Application System">Exchange Application System</a>. The insurance should completely cover your stay in Taiwan.

- ♦ Important Period:
  - Course Pre-selection Period (Before arrival):
     From December 23, 2022, to Jan 3, 2023 via <u>Exchange Student information system</u>
     (Please check your ID & password on <u>Exchange Application System</u>).
    - \*During this period, you could only select courses in your host department/ study level.\*
  - Course Adding and Dropping Period (After Arrival):
     From Feb 20 to Mar 7, 2023, you could change courses on arrival via <u>Exchange Student information</u> system.
    - \*During this period, you could select courses in different departments, and different levels.\*

      If the courses are full, please contact the instructor for the Authorization Code.

What is Authorization Code?

■ Mandarin Class: It cannot be added online directly. Students must attend the class in the first week of the beginning of class to get the authorization code from the instructor. A placement test is required for some of them. *Info HERE*

♦ By Taxi: Fastest and most comfortable after couple-hour flight. It costs around TWD\$1300- 1800 depending on your location. There is a Taxi Spot when arriving at the airport.

## **Accommodation**

#### ♦ On-campus housing:

Due to high demand and limited facilities, accommodation in on-campus dormitories can only be offered to full-time degree students.

### ♦ Off-campus housing:

The private rental market in Taipei offers a wide range of accommodation. Reasonable rates per person per month lie between NT\$ 7000- NT\$ 14000, depending on room types and location. Recommended areas are Da'an District and Zhongzheng District where Taiwan Tech, National Taiwan Normal University, National Taiwan University are located. Many Taiwan Tech students live in Yonghe district in New Taipei City where rents are cheaper than in the city center.
