Competition Items: Men's (or mixed) eight OARS coxswain 1000 m straight race; men's/women's quadruple sculls 1000 m straight race.

Methods of Participation

- The organizing committee will invite the universities to organize the team to participate in the competition. For men's (or mixed men's and women's) coxswain, 8 full OARS, 1 coxswain and 1 substitute, for men's/women's four sculls, 4 full OARS and 1 substitute (the above athletes must hold student ID card or school certificate and be students in their universities), 1 coach, 1 leader, and 4 participants in the post-race performance. Each school has a team of no more than 16 members.
- Each team may change its participants before the leader's draw, but may not change unregistered players. If you need to change the players temporarily under special circumstances after the drawing, you can apply to the Organizing committee, and the Organizing committee will decide whether to allow the change according to the rules.
- All athletes must be fit and able to swim at least 200 meters. Team leaders
 and coaches shall be fully responsible for the swimming ability and health of
 their competitors. Each team leader must sign a safety commitment letter
 with the Organizing committee when reporting for duty.

Competition Method

- The Organizing Committee shall make detailed rules for the competition following the Rules of Rowing Competition of the International Rowing Federation.
- The competition shall be conducted in 6 waterways. 2 and 4 waterways shall be selected according to the schedule of the competition unit. Draw lots before the race to divide the course into groups.
- The competition adopts the two-round system. After the competition, the time
 of the two rounds will be added together to determine the ranking of the team.
 The team with the shorter time will be ranked in front of the ranking, and the
 team with the same time will be ranked in a tie.
- Water training can be arranged for each team the day before the competition.
 Each team shall apply for training after the registration is approved, and the organizing committee will make the training schedule according to the application.
- Before the start of the race, the chief judge shall hold a pre-race leaders'
 meeting to announce the matters needing attention and requirements for the
 race. After the final competitors are determined, the boat and oar drawing
 and race lane drawing shall be conducted respectively.

Competition Method

- All participants in each group shall check-in by boat 40 minutes before the race and get the channel card. If they fail to check in time, they will be treated as an automatic waiver.
- The coxswain is one of the members of the boat. The minimum weight of the coxswain shall not be less than 55 kg. Underweight should be added to the corresponding weight, and be examined by the judge. There is no gender limit for the helmsman.
- The boats and OARS used by each team shall be provided by the Conference (the specific boats shall be decided by drawing lots only); Among them, the coxswain commander of the eight-man single oar event needs to be prepared by each team, and the organizing committee does not provide it;
- All boats must wear uniform clothing.
- If the race cannot be held as scheduled due to weather factors, such as heavy rain, thunder, lightning, or strong wind, no result will be obtained if the race is not held; For partially completed events, the ranking will be determined by the judging group and the Organizing committee.

Referee: Technical representatives and main referees are selected by Tianjin Winter and Water Sports Management Center.

Arbitration Commission: The personnel composition shall be governed by the Rules of Competition of the International Federation.

Admission ranking and awards: The top three winners will be awarded the Championship, second runner-up, and second runner-up trophies. All teams will receive a certificate of participation and a commemorative award.

Registration and registration

- The deadline for registration is June 30, 2023.
- Each participant shall fill in the registration form in the name of the school according to the rules of the competition, and provide one inch of personal identification photo with white background (or blue background). Individual registration is not accepted.
- Each unit shall submit the designated contact person to the Organizing committee and provide accurate contact information (WeChat ID or email).
- All units should arrive at Tianjin for registration and training before 12:00 on July 22, 2023. Teams that do not need training can arrive at the hotel and report before 17:00 on July 22.

Funds

- Transportation, accommodation, and lodging of ASEAN colleges and universities shall be uniformly arranged by the Conference.
- The transportation expenses of domestic colleges and universities shall be borne by themselves, and the transportation expenses and catering expenses during the competition shall be arranged by the conference.
