- Self-Introduction - Statement of Purpose - Study Plan
- Academic transcript with apostille or consular notarization
- Certificate of highest education level achieved, with apostille or consular notarization (Applicable only to nationals of the relevant country).
- Certificate of birth (Certificate of Family Relations) with apostille or consular notarization (Applicable only to nationals of the relevant country.

The Korea Advanced Institute of Science and Technology (KAIST) Language Center issues the 'Certificate of Admission', which is a mandatory document for obtaining a visa for Korean language training. Therefore, please contact the Korean Embassy/Consulate in your country of residence to prepare the necessary documents for the D-4 (Korean language training) visa.
