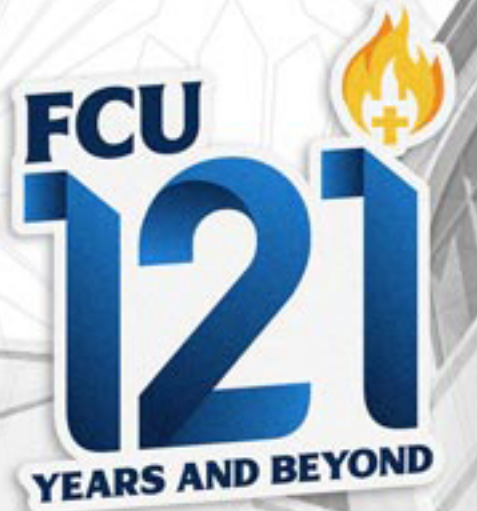

OVERVIEW

"PAGHILIANGOT" HERITAGE JOURNEYS: Bridging Language and Culture

"Paghiliangot" is a Hiligaynon word which means to connect or to gather together, in this essence, it refers to a short-term intercultural engagement program of Filamer Christian University which aims to gather international students and introduce Philippine culture to them through various activities such as basic conversation skills and language learning in Hiligaynon, immersion to cultural communities, exposure to the heritage sites in the province of Capiz and the city of Roxas, awareness of best practices in promoting sustainable tourism and Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs), cultural exchange presentations and discussions, company and industry visit, among others. It is expected that after the week-long cultural study program, the international students will gain broader understanding and learning of Philippine culture, cultivate cross-cultural perspectives, and develop personal and collaborative skills.

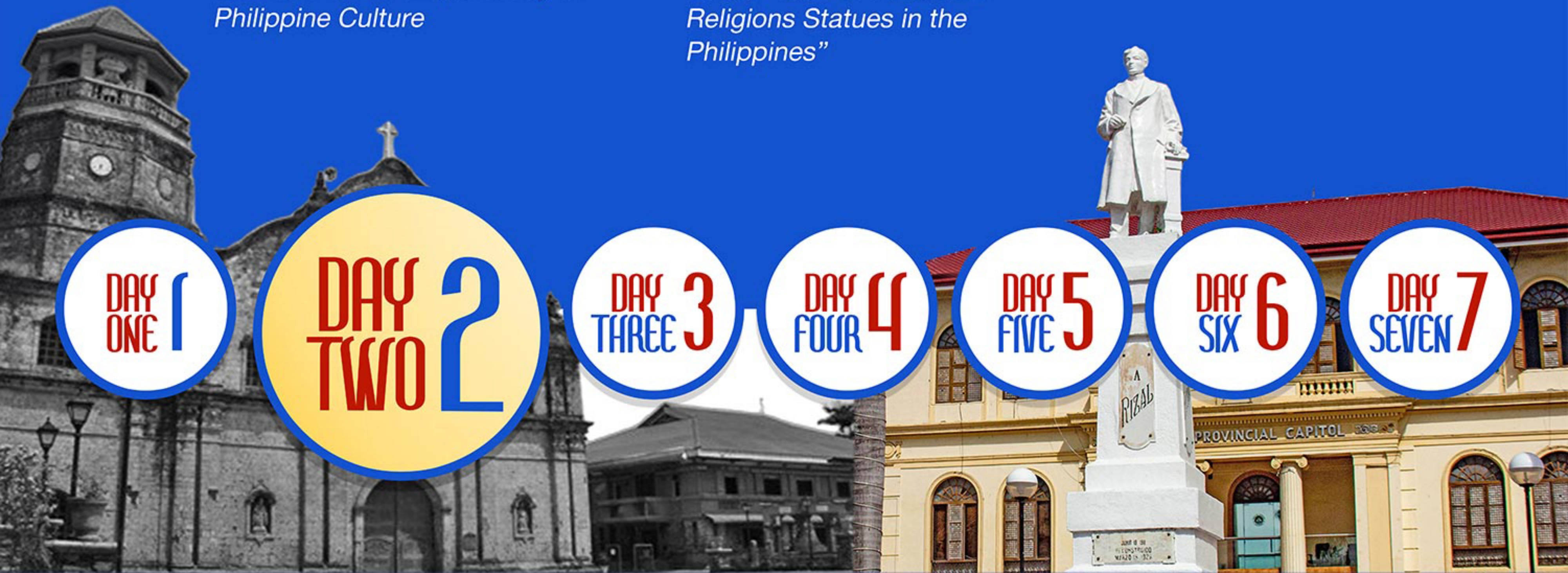
