

Scholarship Scheme for International Students from ASEAN Countries

TJU-UoL Master's Programs

Scholarship Quota & Funding (Total 6 Awards)

- **Full Scholarship: 1 recipient, 150,000 RMB**
- **First-Class Scholarship: 2 recipients, 40,000 RMB each**
- **Second-Class Scholarship: 3 recipients, 10,000 RMB each**

Eligibility Criteria

- Citizen of an ASEAN member state with a valid national passport
- Applicant for TJU-UoL master's programs, meeting official admission requirements
- Bachelor's degree with GPA $\geq 3.0/4.0$ (or equivalent, e.g., UK upper second-class honours)
- English proficiency meets program admission standards (e.g., IELTS 6.5 no band below 6.0)
- Good moral character, abides by Chinese laws and university regulations
- Strong academic potential and willingness to promote Sino-ASEAN academic/cultural exchanges

Selection Process (Merit-Based, Open & Fair)

- Submit online program application with additional scholarship application statement
- Preliminary review: eligibility, application materials, academic & English performance → shortlist interview candidates
- Interview assessment: online/offline English interview

(academic potential, cross-cultural competence)

- Final evaluation & publicity: 5 working days of public notice on the Joint Institute's official website
- Award confirmation: scholarship notice issued with admission letter; funding granted after enrollment
