- Please edit a proper file name. You can follow the reference as follows (paper title – applicant name). If the document is not only one paper, please combine them to one PDF file for the upload. Besides, please make sure all the documents you upload are clear while there should not be any one are blurred.
1. **Photo**—SNKAR WALEED ALI MOHAMMED
 - ※ Please attach a recent 2-inch rectangular photo without a hat, in JPG format.
 2. **Application Fee Receipt**—SNKAR WALEED ALI MOHAMMED
 - ※ OIA can help to collect your registration fees and will request the receipts from the Office of Cashier. The scanned copies will be sent to you later.
 3. **Declaration of Attendance at NFU University**—SNKAR WALEED ALI MOHAMMED
 4. **Autobiography**—SNKAR WALEED ALI MOHAMMED
 - ※ It should be at least 1,000 words, detailed, and well-structured.
 5. **Letter of Authorization**—SNKAR WALEED ALI MOHAMMED
 6. **Certificate of the Highest Academic Degree**—SNKAR WALEED ALI MOHAMMED
 - ※ Please upload the Certificate of Enrollment stamped by home university. You may also include your home university student ID card, but the enrollment certificate is the most important document.
 - ※ Due to stricter examination processes, we recommend uploading at least two enrollment certificates: one from home university and one from NFU (will be provided by OIA later).
 - ※ Please combine both into a single PDF file, ensuring that the home university enrollment certificate appears as the first page and the NFU enrollment certificate as the second page.
 7. **Original Copy of Transcript**—SNKAR WALEED ALI MOHAMMED
 - ※ An English version of the transcripts for all semesters, stamped by home university.
 8. **Two letters of Recommendation**—SNKAR WALEED ALI MOHAMMED
 - ※ If possible, obtaining one recommendation letter from an NFU professor (such as your current project advisor or a course instructor) and another from a home university's professor is more persuasive than having both letters from the home university's professors. This is a suggestion, not

a requirement. If all of your documents are well-prepared and meet the qualifications, having two recommendation letters from the same university will not be an issue. [Please combine the two recommendation letters into a single PDF file for uploading, as there is only one slot available for uploading both letters.](#)

9. **Study Plan** – SNKAR WALEED ALI MOHAMMED

- ※ It should be at least 1,000 words, detailed, and well-structured. You may upload the typed version of your autobiography and study plan directly, without the need to print or sign them. Focus on presenting your strengths, motivation, and goals while emphasizing the following key points.
- A. **Introduce yourself as a student:** Highlight your positive traits, such as optimism, diligence, and enthusiasm for learning. This helps the admissions committee understand your personality.
- B. **Educational background:** Describe your academic achievements at home university, including any significant projects, extracurricular activities, or competition experiences that have shaped your academic path.
- C. **Specialized skills and certifications:** Mention any specific technical skills, certifications, or qualifications that set you apart from other candidates. Provide concrete examples of how you've applied these skills.
- D. **Why NFU?** Clearly explain your interest in studying at National Formosa University. Make sure to connect NFU's strengths with your own research and academic goals.
- E. **Internship experience:** Describe your experiences in the NFU Formosa Talent Internship Program (FTIP). Share details about the project work and classes you have participated in, emphasizing what you have learned so far.
- F. **Goals for knowledge acquisition:** Specify the areas of knowledge you hope to gain during your master's program. Be specific about the skills and concepts you wish to deepen.
- G. **Connecting FTIP to future thesis work:** Explain how your FTIP project work could form the basis of or connect to your future master's thesis. This shows foresight and a long-term vision for your studies.
- H. **Research plan for Master's thesis:** Outline your intended research topic for your formal master's thesis. Be clear about what you want to explore and why it's important. Highlight how NFU's resources will help you achieve your research goals.
- I. **Career goals after graduation:** Share your long-term professional goals and how completing the master's program will help you achieve them. Provide a clear plan for how you intend to use the knowledge gained in your future career.
- **Suggestions for strengthening your study plan**
 - a. **Be specific:** Avoid general statements. Provide detailed descriptions and examples of your skills, accomplishments, and research interests.
 - b. **Show enthusiasm:** Demonstrate genuine passion for your field of study. The admissions committee is more likely to respond positively if they see your motivation and dedication.
 - c. **Tie past experiences to future goals:** Connect your past academic and professional experiences to your future aspirations, showing a clear path of development and purpose.
 - d. **Highlight growth:** Emphasize how your experiences at home university and NFU have contributed to both your academic and personal growth. Demonstrating how you've evolved is crucial to convincing the committee that you're ready for graduate studies.

- e. **Plan your thesis with precision:** Having a clear thesis idea shows that you've thought critically about your future research. Make sure it aligns with the expertise available at NFU.
 - f. **Avoid superficiality:** Don't submit a brief or generic study plan. **Some of your seniors had their applications rejected due to study plans that lacked depth and failed to show clear motivation or passion.**
10. **Certification for Language Proficiency** – SNKAR WALEED ALI MOHAMMED
 11. **Financial Support Statement** – SNKAR WALEED ALI MOHAMMED
 - ※ If the bank statement is from [your parent's account](#) instead of your personal account, [it must include both your and your parent's full names, account details, a statement of your relationship](#), and ideally indicate that the bank statement is intended to support your studies overseas. Due to the limited structure of some bank statements, you may need to provide additional proof, such as a certificate of family relationship.
 - ※ **Based on the experience of previous students, preparing the financial proof is relatively difficult. Please make sure to start preparing it early to avoid delaying your application schedule.**
 12. **Photocopy of Certifications for Other Capabilities** – SNKAR WALEED ALI MOHAMMED
 - ※ In this section, you can upload any certificates or supporting documents that may strengthen your application.
 13. **Verification of Nationality** – SNKAR WALEED ALI MOHAMMED
 - ※ Passport Copy ([Personal information page](#))
 14. **Deposition related to application documents** – SNKAR WALEED ALI MOHAMMED
 15. **Portfolio** – SNKAR WALEED ALI MOHAMMED
 - ※ If you are applying to any department that requires additional documents, please make sure to upload them, such as a portfolio or any other specified materials.

- When uploading the following 5 documents, you **do not** need to print, sign, and scan these documents. Instead, you can create [a digital signature](#) directly on each document before uploading. To ensure there are no issues, [please make sure to add your digital signature to all five documents](#).
 - Documents 1 and 2 will be reviewed by the department committee. Some committees may not require the applicant's signature, while others might.
 - Documents 3 to 5 will be strictly reviewed by the Office of Academic Affairs, where a signature is mandatory.
 - Except for the signature and date, other content in these documents can be typed instead of handwritten.
