
Main Campus (Gajwa)

2. Procedures

- 1) **Submit the nomination form** (Exchange Program Coordinator)
 - Nomination form will be sent via email
- 2) **Prepare the application form and documents** (Student)
 - Will be sent via email, along with the nomination form
- 3) **Submit the application form and documents** (Exchange Program Coordinator)
 - Please submit the form and documents through the exchange program coordinator
- 4) **Documents for VISA issuance** (GNU)
 - For successful applicants, the necessary documents for visa application purposes (Certificate of Admission, Letter of Acceptance, etc.) will be sent out via email.

3. Guidelines

◎ Submission

- **via email**(mash24@gnu.ac.kr) **by the exchange program coordinator**
 - File format : ▫ ① Application form ➔ **MS Word**
 - ② ~ ⑧ ➔ combined in a **single PDF** in the correct order
 - Files name : must be written as **HOME UNIVERSITY NAME_PROGRAM_STUDENT NAME** (in capital letters)
 - ex) Application Form ➔ KOREA STATE UNIVERSITY_EXCHANGE_SANGHYUN SAMUEL MA
 - ex) PDF ➔ KOREA STATE UNIVERSITY_EXCHANGE_SANGHYUN SAMUEL MA
- ※ Please do not just copy and paste the example

◎ List of Documents ※ all documents must be prepared in English

- ① Application Form (form provided by GNU)
- ② Copy of Passport ※ **Picture page & signature page**
- ③ Certificate of Enrollment (in English)
- ④ Official Academic Transcript (in English)
 - ※ Graduate students : must submit undergraduate academic transcript also
- ⑤ Medical Checkup (form provided by GNU)
- ⑥ Permission for the Use of Personal Information (form provided by GNU)
 - Can be signed in ink or electronically
- ⑦ Letter of Recommendation
 - Free format, and must be written in English
 - Make sure to include the recommender's name, affiliation, position(title), signature(ink or electronically), and reason for recommendation
- ⑧ Passport Photo (3.5*4.5cm)

※ Only documents **issued within 3 months are valid**

※ (For Students) Files that are not submitted in accordance with the guidelines may not be reviewed. Please make sure to check carefully before submitting

5. Course Language

- ◎ GNU does not have an official English track
 - Korean is the primary language of instruction, and course offered in English is very limited
 - Courses taught in English may refer to the link below for your reference

 - ※ Courses not included in the list are conducted in Korean
 - ※ As most major courses are taught in Korean, please ensure that you carefully prepare and submit your 'study plan' to your home university
 - ※ Course offerings may vary each semester, so the link should be used just for reference only

6. Course Registration

- ◎ Course registration period: one month before the start of the semester(Details TBA via email)
- ◎ Course registration is a '**first-come, first-served basis**'
 - Students may **not be able** to enroll in all the courses they initially planned. Therefore, we **strongly recommend preparing backup course options (2nd, 3rd choices) in advance.**
 - **This applies to all students, both domestic and international**
- ◎ In certain countries, access to course registration system may be unstable or unavailable
 - students may register courses during the 'course adjustment period', first week of the semester
 - However, since it is 'first-come, first-served' basis, please understand that securing your preferred courses may be difficult
- ◎ GNU uses the U.S. credit system: 1 credit consists of 1 hour coursework per week
 - ※ It is not allowed to register for major courses outside your department
 - ※ Most major courses are taught in Korean, and the dropout rate among international students is relatively high
 - ※ Course registration may be restricted depending on your department, academic year, and prerequisite requirements, and such restrictions can only be confirmed at the time of course registration
 - ※ Please note that no exceptions can be made to increase class capacity or override enrollment limits under any circumstances, even for exchange students
 - ※ We kindly ask you to prepare alternative course plans in case you are unable to enroll in your initially intended courses

7. Note for Graduates

© Graduate students are eligible to participate in the exchange program; however, they will be registered in the system as undergraduate students for administrative purposes

※ Regardless of the registration status, exchange students who wish to take graduate level courses must obtain prior approval from the respective course instructor

1. Airport pick-up service

- ◎ Free airport pickup service will be provided
- ◎ Pickup date, time and airport may vary each semester
- ◎ A pre-arrival survey will be sent via email to selected exchange program participants

2. Orientation

- ◎ An orientation (OT) for international students will be held on the Friday of the week before the semester begins, where we will go over important information
 - exact date and time will be provided by the person in charge via an email

3. Health insurance

- ◎ All international students must obtain an Alien Registration Card (ARC)
- ◎ After ARC is issued, students will be automatically enrolled in the Korean National Health Insurance (NHI)
 - Enrollment in NHI is mandatory for all foreign residents in Korea
 - It cannot be refused or canceled under any circumstances, even if students already have health insurance coverage in their home country
- ◎ Insurance fee must be paid by the student
 - Estimated Amount(KRW): 84,150 (each month)

4. Buddy program

- ◎ Each exchange student will be assigned one Korean student and can receive assistance with the following:
 - Course registration and adjustments
 - Participating in on-campus events
 - Overall support with campus life and daily life in Korea
