The Global Summer School 2026 at UEH offers students an immersive experience to explore Vietnam's economy, culture, and society through academic learning, cultural exchange, and experiential activities in Ho Chi Minh City.

Academic Modules

Vietnamese Economy

- Introduction to Vietnam's economic development and global integration
- Understanding Vietnam's dynamic business environment

Sustainable Development

- Exploring sustainability challenges and development strategies in Vietnam
- Discussions on environmental and social responsibility

Vietnamese Culture

- Discovering Vietnam's traditions, history, and cultural identity
- Cultural exchange activities with UEH students

Company Tours

- Visits to Vietnamese enterprises and organizations
- Opportunities to observe real business practices in Vietnam

Fees Include:

- Airport pick-up and drop-off
- 3 meals per day (Vietnamese & international options)
- Academic lectures and workshops at UEH
- Cultural activities and city tours
- On-campus accommodation
- Certificate of Completion from UEH

Fees Exclude:

- International airfare
- Personal expenses
- Visa application fees
- Travel insurance
- Additional sightseeing outside the program schedule
- Meals outside the official itinerary

Remarks

- Fees may vary depending on group size and program customization.
- Participants are responsible for personal belongings and any damages caused during the program.

Certificate and Transcript

Upon successful completion of the program, participants will receive a Certificate of Completion and an Academic Transcript issued by **University of Economics Ho Chi Minh City**.

The two-week program offers **2 academic credits**, while the four-week program offers **5 academic credits**, including participation in company tours.

All classes and program activities are mandatory. Detailed syllabi will be provided upon acceptance to the program.

The academic modules include:

- Vietnamese Economy
- Sustainable Development
- Vietnamese Culture
- Company Tours (for the four-week program)

Four-Week Academic, Cultural, and Industry Exchange Program

Week	Theme	Activities
<i>Weeks 1–2 follow the program schedule described in the previous section.</i>		
Week 3 – Academic Study (Credit Courses)	Academic learning	Students attend formal academic classes to earn credits. Courses offered include Vietnamese Economy, Sustainable Development, and Vietnamese Culture. Teaching methods include lectures, seminars, case studies, and group discussions.
Week 4 – Industry Exposure & Academic Integration	Industry engagement and program conclusion	Company tours to Vietnamese enterprises and organizations to understand Vietnam’s business environment and economic development. Activities may include guest lectures from industry professionals, student group project presentations, program reflection, and a farewell ceremony.

The two-week program offers **2 academic credits**, while the four-week program offers **5 academic credits** and includes company tours.
