# SELECTION REQUIREMENTS FOR FULL SCHOLARSHIP APPLICANTS

**1. ASEAN Citizenship:** Applicants must be citizens of an ASEAN member state.

## **2. Age and Academic Background**

- Currently enrolled undergraduate student
- Age: 18 - 22 years old
- Minimum GPA: 2.8/4.0 (or equivalent)

## **3. English Proficiency**

- Able to communicate and collaborate effectively in English
- Recommended minimum level: B1 CEFR or equivalent

## **4. Demonstrated Interest in Culture and Collaboration**

- Strong interest in AI, innovation, emerging technologies, or solving real-world challenges
- Curiosity, creativity, and willingness to explore AI applications across different disciplines
- Experience in leadership, projects, competitions, student activities, or collaborative initiatives is a plus

## **5. Commitment to Full Participation**

Selected students must commit to:

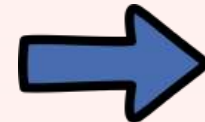
- Pre-arrival group meetings

# NOMINATION PROCEDURES

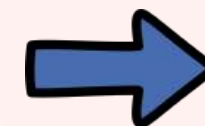
1.

The University partner selects students based on the **FPT scholarship selection requirements.**



2.

The partner nominates students to FPT by sending a name list via email and ensures that **the selected students complete the registration form.**



3.

Scholarships will be offered by FPT based on the remaining scholarship quota available and will be allocated on a first-come, first-served basis.

## **Key notes:**

- Nomination deadline: **06 June, 2026**
- FPT will not accept any students without prior notification from our partner via email.
- Once all scholarship slots have been filled, subsequent nominated students will automatically be considered under **the self-funded seats.**

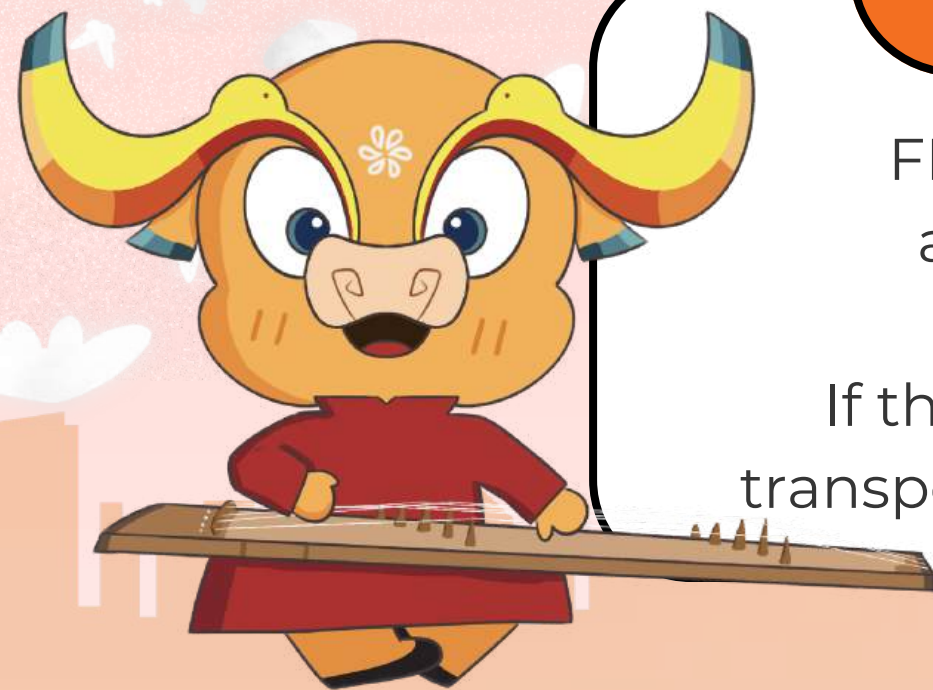

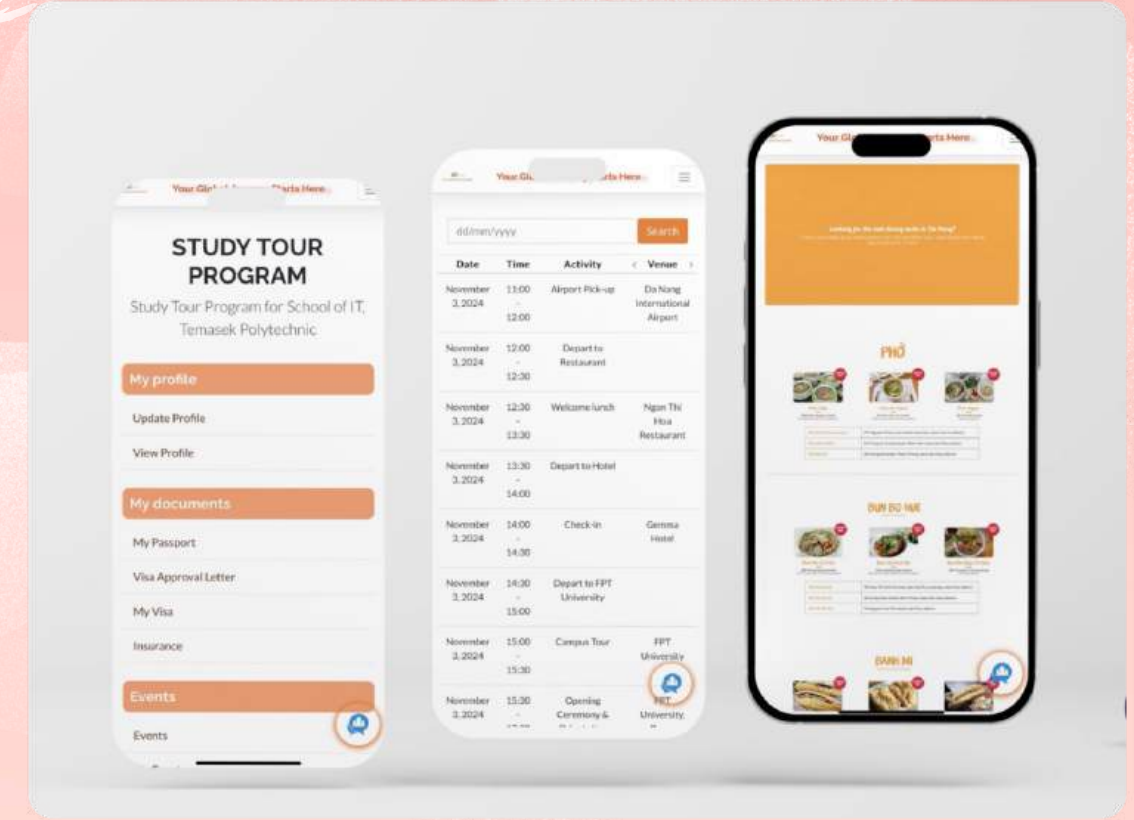
