※ DB Insurance: Since National Health Insurance (NHI) coverage begins 1–2 months after arrival, the university provides temporary private insurance until then.

3 Issuing Admission Certificate

After verifying the fees are paid, certificate of admission will be sent to the student & coordinator via email.

4 Application for VISA

Please visit the official website of the Korean Embassy or Consulate in your home country to find information on how to apply for a student visa.

The expected timeline for visa issuance varies by country. Please check the embassy's website for specific processing times.

Be sure to prepare the required documents and apply for your visa early to ensure your arrival on time.

Important: If you do not apply for a visa within one month of the Admission Certificate's issuance date, the embassy may reject your application.

National Health Insurance

Upon their arrival in Korea, all exchange students are mandated to undergo the alien registration process. This step is typically completed by mid-April, and upon its conclusion, students are seamlessly enrolled in the mandatory national health insurance scheme (about 80 USD per month).

However, between their entry and their inclusion in the national health insurance, students are required to avail the DB insurance for approximately two months, incurring a cost of around 50 USD.
