ORGANIZATION AND WORKING PROCEDURE OF FACULTIES IN SEPULUH NOPEMBER INSTITUTE OF TECHNOLOGY

BY THE MERCY OF GOD THE ALMIGHTY RECTOR OF SEPULUH NOPEMBER INSTITUTE OF TECHNOLOGY,

- Considering: a. That to implement Article 33 of Rector Regulation of Sepuluh Nopember Institute of Technology Number 24 of 2019 regarding Organization and Working Procedure of Sepuluh Nopember Institute of Technology, it is necessary to establish the organization and working procedure of faculties:
 - b. That the organization and working procedure of faculties in Sepuluh Nopember Institute of Technology has been obtained consideration from the Board of Trustees based on Letter Number B/93834/IT2.MWA/TU.00.09/2019;
 - c. That based on the consideration referred to in letter a and b above, it needs to establish Rector Regulation regarding Organization and Working Procedure of Faculties in Sepuluh Nopember Institute of Technology:

DECIDED:

Establishing: RECTOR REGULATION REGARDING ORGANIZATION AND WORKING PROCEDURE OF FACULTIES IN SEPULUH NOPEMBER INSTITUTE OF TECHNOLOGY

CHAPTER I GENERAL PROVISIONS Article 1

In the Regulation, those referred to as:

1. Sepuluh Nopember Institute of Technology hereinafter abbreviated as ITS is a legal entity state university.

- 2. Statutes of ITS are basic rules of ITS management that serve as the foundation of drafting of regulations and operational procedures in ITS.
- 3. Rector is an ITS organ who leads the implementation and management of ITS
- 4. Vice Rector is a Rector's assistant in the implementation and management of ITS in certain strategic field.
- 5. Faculty is an element of academic organizer which is a set of supporting resources in the implementation and management of academic education, professional education, and/or vocational education in a family of scientific discipline and technology.
- Department is an element of Faculty that supports the implementation of academic activities in one or some branches of science and technology in types of academic education, vocational education, and/or professional education.
- 7. Study Program is a unit of educational and learning activities which has specific curriculum and learning method in a type of academic education, vocational education, and/or professional education.

CHAPTER II FACULTY Article 2

- (1) A Faculty is in charge of:
 - a. Arranging the planning, governance, and development of programs and services within the Faculty and the departments under it in field of education, research, collaboration, and community service;
 - b. Collaborating and sharing resources within Faculty and the departments under it;
 - c. Evaluating the performance of work programs within Faculty; and
 - d. Providing excellent service in field of education, research, collaboration, and community service with principles of bureaucracy reformation and integrity zone.
- (2) In performing the duties as referred to in verse (1), a Faculty performs the functions of:
 - a. Formulation of operational plan of Faculty in field of education, research, collaboration, and community service;

- b. Management of cross-department programs within Faculty in field of education, research, collaboration, and community service;
- c. Coordination in promoting the potentials of Faculty and external collaboration based on the potentials of each department or crossdepartment;
- d. Coordination in management and development of education and student affairs within Faculty;
- e. Development human resources;
- f. Implementation of quality insurance and control in academic and non-academic fields in Faculty;
- g. Coordination, evaluation, and follow-ups of results of quality insurance reports in departments and Faculty;
- h. Coordination of scientific publication authentication verification of Departments;
- Evaluation and monitoring of finance, process standards and services;
 and
- j. Implementation of evaluation and reporting of implementation of work programs of Faculty in field of education, research, collaboration, and community service.

- (1) The Faculties in ITS consist of:
 - a. Faculty of Science and Data Analytics;
 - b. Faculty of Industrial Technology and System Engineering;
 - c. Faculty of Civil, Planning, and Geo Engineering;
 - d. Faculty of Marine Technology;
 - e. Faculty of Intelligent Electrical and Informatics Technology;
 - f. Faculty of Creative Design and Digital Business; and
 - g. Faculty of Vocational.
- (2) Names of Departments in each Faculty as referred to in verse (1) are established through Rector Decision.

Section 1

Organization Structure of Faculty

Article 4

- (1) The organization structure under Faculty organ consists of:
 - a. Dean and Vice Dean;
 - b. Faculty Consideration Committee;
 - c. Departments; and
 - d. Faculty Administration Division.
- (2) Departments as referred to in verse (1) letter c above consist of:
 - a. Study Programs; and
 - b. Laboratory, Workshop, Teaching Factory, Studio, and/or Garage.
- (3) Faculty Administration Division as referred to in verse (1) letter c is assisted by Department Administration Sub-Division.

Section 2

Dean and Vice Dean

Article 5

- (1) A Faculty is led by a Dean, who in performing the duties is responsible to Rector.
- (2) Dean is in charge of performing the duties and functions of Faculty.
- (3) In performing the duties, Dean is assisted by 1 (one) Vice Dean.
- (4) Vice Dean as referred to in verse (3) is responsible to Dean and is in charge of assisting Dean in performing the duties and functions of Faculty especially in management of finance, facilities and infrastructure, human resources, and serves as the commitment-making official of Faculty.

Section 3

Faculty Consideration Committee

- (1) Faculty Consideration Committee for Faculty as referred to in Article 3 verse (1) is in charge of providing considerations in academic and non-academic fields and organizing doctoral promotion hearing and judicium.
- (2) In performing the duties as referred to in verse (1), Faculty Consideration Committee performs the functions of:

- a. Provision of considerations in preparation and development of work programs of Faculty;
- b. Provision of considerations in preparation of income and expenditure budget plans;
- c. Provision of considerations on awards of academic appreciation;
- d. Provision of considerations on sanctions on academicians upon cases of violation against academic code of conduct and other applicable regulations;
- e. Provision of considerations in proposals of lecturer promotion; and
- f. Implementation of doctoral promotion hearing and judicium.
- (3) Further provisions regarding procedures of appointment and dismissal of members and management of Faculty Consideration Committee are provided in Rector Regulation.

Section Five

Departments and Study Programs

- (1) A Department is in charge of managing and organizing the activities of Three Pillars of Higher Education and quality insurance in some education levels in a family of scientific discipline and technology for types of academic education, professional education, or vocational education.
- (2) In performing the duties as referred to in verse (1), a Department performs the functions of:
 - a. Planning and management of Three Pillars of Higher Education and collaboration in one of and/or some branches of science and technology;
 - b. Coordination and integration of activities of study programs related to the implementation of Three Pillars of Higher Education;
 - c. Implementation of management system of higher education, performance achievement of Departments in accordance with strategic plans;
 - d. Implementation of quality insurance and control in academic and non-academic fields in Departments;
 - e. Coordination, evaluation, and follow-ups of results of quality insurance of study programs in departments;

- f. Management and empowerment of laboratories, studios, and/or workshops;
- g. Management of student activities; and
- h. Management of scientific publication authentication verification.
- (3) A Department is led by a Head of Department, who in performing the duties is responsible to Dean.
- (4) Head of Department as referred to in verse (3) in performing the duties is assisted by 2 (two) Department Secretaries at most.
- (5) Department Secretaries as referred to in verse (4) consist of:
 - a. Department Secretary I who is responsible to Head of Department and is in charge of assisting Head of Department in field of academic, student affairs, research, and community service;
 - b. Department Secretary II who is responsible to Head of Department and is in charge of assisting Head of Department in field of financial resources, human resources, and facilities and infrastructures.
- (6) The number of formations of Department Secretaries as referred to in verse (4) and nomenclature are to be established through Rector Decision.
- (7) Department Secretaries as referred to in verse (4) are responsible to Head of Department.

Article 8

- (1) A Study Program is in charge of organizing learning activities on an education level related to a family of scientific discipline and technology for types of academic education, professional education, or vocational education.
- (2) In performing the duties as referred to in verse (1), a Study Program performs the functions of:
 - a. Implementation of learning process;
 - b. Preparation and development of curriculum; and
 - c. Implementation of quality insurance and control of learning process.
- (3) Study Program as referred to in verse (1) is led by a Head of Study Program who in performing the duties is responsible to Head of Department.

- (1) A Laboratory/ Teaching Factory/ Studio/ Workshop is in charge of organizing activities of Three Pillars of Higher Education to support the performance of duties within Department.
- (2) In performing the duties as referred to in verse (1), Laboratory/ Teaching Factory/ Studio/ Workshop performs the functions of:
 - a. Implementation of learning activities;
 - b. Implementation of research; and
 - c. Implementation of community service.
- (3) Laboratory/ Teaching Factory/ Studio/ Workshop as referred to in verse
 (1) is led by a Head of Laboratory/ Teaching Factory/ Studio/ Workshop who in performing the duties is responsible to Head of Department.

Section Six

Faculty Administration Division

Article 10

- (1) A Faculty Administration Division is in charge of organizing the administration in fields of:
 - a. Development and management of education within Faculty;
 - b. Quality insurance and control of implementation of Three Pillars of Higher Education;
 - c. Management, development, and implementation of collaboration in field of Three Pillars of Higher Education;
 - d. Management and development of resources including finance, general employee affairs, and facilities and infrastructures.
- (2) In performing the duties as referred to in verse (1), Faculty Administration Division performs the functions of:
 - a. Implementation of education administration;
 - b. Implementation of financial administration and employee affairs;
 - c. Implementation of general affairs and equipment; and
 - d. Implementation of student and alumnus administration.
- (3) Faculty Administration Division is led by a Head of Division, who in performing the duties is responsible to Dean.

Article 11

(1) A Department Administration Sub-Division is in charge of organizing the administration within Department in field of implementation and

management of higher education and assisting the duties of Head of Faculty Administration Division in:

- a. Quality insurance and control of implementation of Three Pillars of Higher Education;
- b. Management, development, and implementation of collaboration in field of Three Pillars of Higher Education; and
- c. Management and development of resources including finance, general employee affairs, and facilities and infrastructures.
- (2) Department Administration Sub-Division is led by a Head of Sub-Division, who in performing the duties coordinates with Head of Department and is responsible to Head of Faculty Administration Division.
- (3) Head of Department Administration Sub-Division as referred to in verse (2) can perform the duties for a Department or more, which is to be established through Rector Decision.

CHAPTER III

TRANSITIONAL PROVISIONS

Article 12

- (1) The Faculties as referred to in Article 3 verse (1) are effective starting from January 2020.
- (2) The process of election of Dean and Vice Dean is implemented after establishment of Rector Regulation regarding Appointment and Dismissal of Dean and Vice Dean.

Article 13

The existing organization units of faculties remain functioning as long as not adjusted to the Rector Regulation.

Article 14

Adjustment of organization units of faculties based on the Regulation is done no later than 1 (one) year since the establishment of the Rector Regulation.

CHAPTER IV CLOSING PROVISION

Article 15

The Rector Regulation applies since the date of establishment.
