When you choose to enter ITS and commence the Bachelor of Management, you may be eligible to transfer to UQ after you successfully complete three semesters (providing you have met certain entry requirements). Continue your next three semesters within the UQ Bachelor of Business Management and then return home to complete your final semester. Graduate with both the UQ and ITS degrees upon completion of your 3.5 years of study.

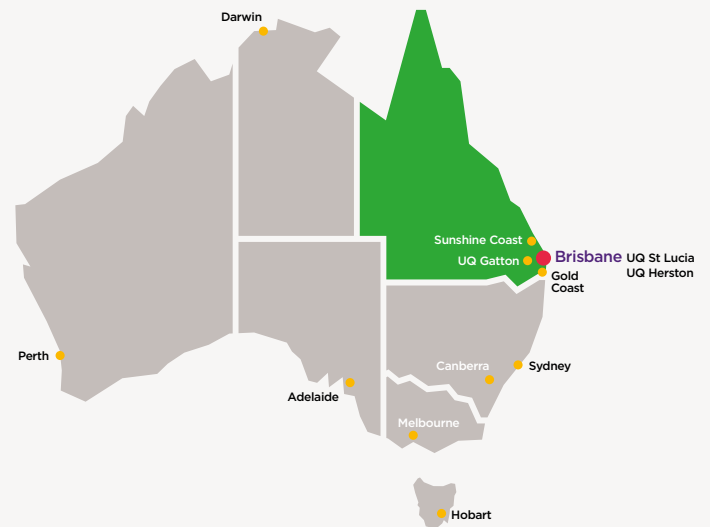
Welcome to Queensland
