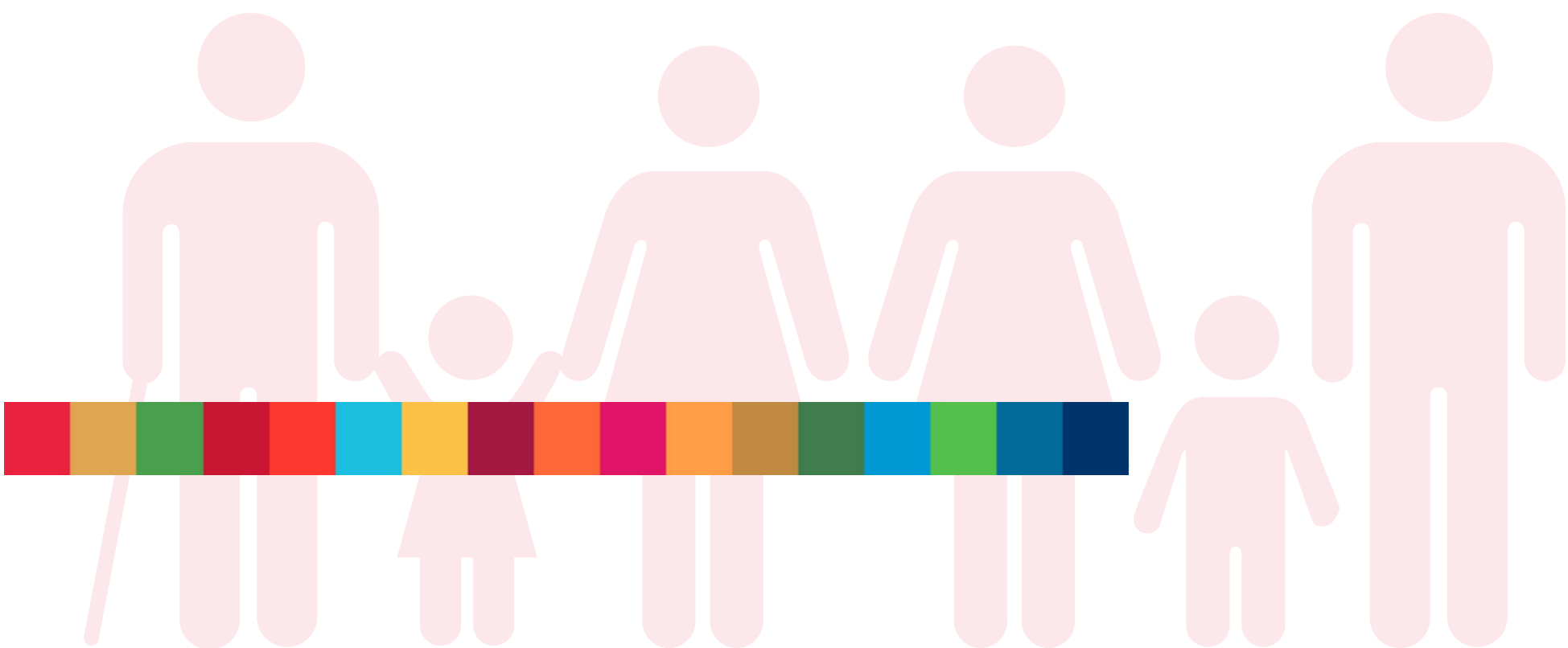

ITS Supports Students from Low-Income Family

The COVID-19 pandemic has affected the ITS community's economic downfall. Therefore, in commemorating the 61st ITS Anniversary, ITS distributes scholarships to help ease the School Fees of ITS students affected by the pandemic. With the help of alumni, ITS student's parents, the community, and other stakeholders, the amount of endowment funds that are successfully compiled is 30 billion rupiahs and will be given to 61 students. The Scholarship Program from ITS is also a part of the collaboration between ITS and the Indonesian Waqf Board (BWI) in developing ITS Endowment Fund management.
