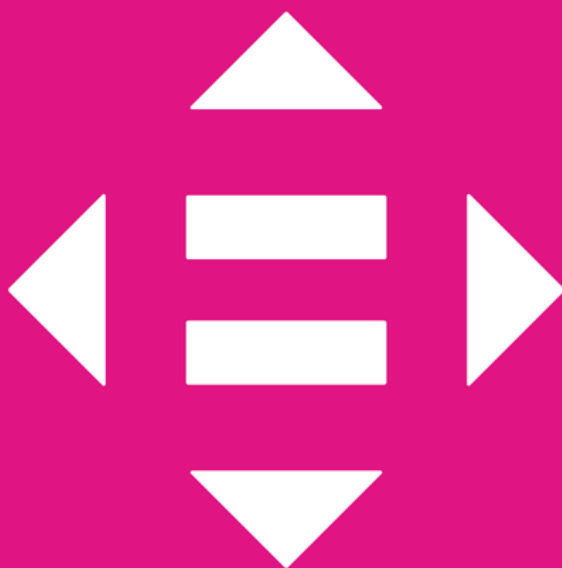

ITS Provides an Inclusive Evacuation



Earthquakes often hit Indonesia due to their location on the tectonic plates. The British Government collaborates with the Surabaya City Government at the Global Future Cities Program (GFCP). In contrast, one of the goals is to provide a safe environment for the disabled community. To implement the program, ITS is chosen to create an Inclusive Evacuation Path for Disability Schools. The project was personally designed and inaugurated at YPAB's Junior and High School Sekolah Luar Biasa for the Blind.
